

simple installation

- Premium multi-purpose or releasable adhesive is recommended.
- · Dry fit the precut carpet into the room, centering the carpet and allowing the surplus to lap against the walls evenly. Make sure there is enough carpet to reach to the centre of thresholds in doorways and pattern match.
- · When seams are necessary, they should be cut first. Row cut the edges removing a minimum 25mm of foam from the factory edge. Do not double cut seams. Row cutting from the face is recommended with sharp cutting tools. Cut each seam edge separately.
- · After seams are matched, make sure the pattern and nap are aligned. Then, fold the carpet back at the seam areas. Do not compress the seam. Seam cuts should all be neat cuts.
- · Apply adhesive to floor using a short notched trowel. Follow adhesive label instructions relating to open time.
- · Secure the seams in accordance with CRI standard 104.
